

The First Flag Over the United Colonies Band Festival will be held on Wednesday, October 4 (raindate Thursday, October 5) at our own Cottingham Stadium. Get a Good Night's Sleep

On Saturday, October 14th, from 10 am to 5 pm, the Easton IMA will hold its first annual Mattress Sale Fundraiser. There will be 25 different mattress brands and styles to choose from

These brandnamed mattresses are not only being offered at a discounted price, but your instrumental student and the IMA will receive in total between \$75-\$150 in music money for each mattress sold.
