## UNIFORM CARE

- Be sure their black uniform pants are hung neatly on the hanger in the garment bag
- Hang raincoats with 2-3 snaps closed to keep it neat on the hanger
- Be sure to keep the raincoat labelled with student name, replace with painter's tape if needed (no duck tape!)
